Dr. Kathleen Scott recently joined the Office of Undergraduate Education as the Assistant Vice President of Instructional Support. She is also Director of the Rutgers Science Explorer program and Professor of Cell Biology and Neuroscience. Dr. Scott earned her doctorate at Yale University, and has served on the Rutgers faculty since 1978. She is Director of the Math and Science Learning Center and Principle Investigator of the Rutgers NSF-funded Graduate Teaching Fellows program, "Building a Learning Community in Mathematics and Science through Educational Partnerships." She currently teaches an introductory course, Moving Bodies, to non-science majors at Rutgers. Dr. Scott is also a Research Associate at the Smithsonian Institution, where she is currently working on the muscular anatomy of the pygmy hippopotamus.
